

Revision Suggestions for 3rd Re-entry of Multi-Voiced, Question-Driven  
Inquiry Inspired by a Personal Experience

- Clarify your **inquiry**. What intersection of specific variables are you exploring? How so? Why? Revise your how & why question to reflect your clarified inquiry.
- Increase **showing**. Let us witness more of the event(s) as if it is unfolding in front of us. See comments.
- Identify, name, show, and discuss other related **contexts** that, if pursued, will help to reveal greater complexity regarding your experience and the related factors and/or outcomes.
- Re-enter your contexts (in process) to increase showing and/or to clarify the relationship(s) and meaning between the context(s) and your experience. See comments.
- Identify, name, show, and discuss other related **factors** that, if pursued, will help to reveal greater complexity regarding your experience and the related contexts and/or outcomes.
- Re-enter your factors (in process) to increase showing and/or to clarify the relationship(s) and meaning between the factor(s) and your experience. See comments.
- Identify, name, show, and discuss other related **outcomes** that, if pursued, will help to reveal greater complexity regarding your experience and the related contexts and/or factors.
- Re-enter your outcomes (in process) to increase showing and/or to clarify the relationship(s) and meaning between the related outcomes and your experience. See comments.
- Up your credibility in terms of sources. Please choose/use at least three (3) credible, **academic sources** from our Healey Library databases. Peer reviewed is best when available.
- Re-enter your **presentation of sources**. Create a transition that expresses the meaning of the source's purpose and order in your inquiry/essay. See comments.
- Re-enter your **discussion of sources**. Be sure to express how and why this source has meaning in your essay as it relates to your experience and related contexts, factors, and/or outcomes. See comments.
- Re-enter and revise your **in-text citations**. Please refer to MLA guidelines. See comments.
- Re-enter and revise your **last paragraph**. Share questions and insights, revealed during this inquiry, about your experience and/or the larger issue, seen through the lenses of all related contexts, factors, and outcomes. See comments.
- Reread your essay aloud (with a tutor or partner if possible) and listen for and mark passages that don't quite sound/read as you'd like them to sound/read. Please attend to these sentences until they **sound right** to you.
- Create or revise your **Works Cited page**. Please see MLA guidelines. See comments.
- Please proofread and attend to **sentence-level issues**. (see words and phrases that are underlined but not attached to comments)
- Please make an appointment with your **tutor** for support as you revise.
